To promote academic activities and create an atmosphere of learning.

To record students' personal data and other learning experience records. systematically to help students pursue further studies or develop their career.

To enhance teachers' development through holding different professional development activities.

To enhance the teaching efficiency through perfecting the appraisal. system.

To conduct meetings for syllabus distribution amongst the faculty.



Procedure: The syllabus as prescribed by the university is allotted to the faculty taking into account their clinical, academic & administrative commitments and in due consultation with the heads of the departments. To formulate and conduct the program for slow performers and advanced learners in collaboration with the year coordinators. To conduct mid-term and end of the year feedback from the students for the teaching learning methodologies and syllabus.
