At the completion of this program, the student should be -

- 1. Be able to do a physical therapy diagnosis using a framework of ICF that is to identify the impairment of body structure, body function, environmental and personal factors and to address the activity limitations and participation restrictions. Able to execute all routine physiotherapeutic procedures with clinical reasoning & evidence based practice.
- 2. Able to be a prominent member of the multidisciplinary team and treat all the conditions which need physiotherapeutic procedures.
- 3. Able to provide adequate knowledge about the treatment procedures and its benefits.
- 4. Able to transfer knowledge and skills to students as well as young professionals.
- 5. Able to perform independent physiotherapy assessment and treatment for patients.
- 6. To plan and implement need based physiotherapy interventions for all clinical conditions related to respective speciality in acute, chronic cases, critical care, independent practice including health promotion and prevention.
- 7. Able to undertake independent research in the field of physiotherapy.
- 8. Learn multidisciplinary practice skills.
- 9. Able to practice and assess patients independently.
- 10. Able to practice in his / her specialty area with advanced knowledge and skills.
- 11. Able to take up physiotherapy teaching assignments independently for undergraduate teaching programmes.
